2. Message to the Diocese.

Our Holy Father calls on each of us to become synodal. This is a watershed moment in the history of the Church. It is my hope and prayer that we will seize this moment and allow the Holy Spirit to penetrate our innermost being and transform us into true disciples of Christ whose sole purpose is to seek and do the will of God like Mary, our Mother.

His Grace, Archbishop Dabula Mpako of Pretoria and myself are the two Bishops' who will represent the Southern African Bishops' Conference (SACBC) at the Synod on Synodality that will take place from 04-29 October. What an honour this is for us! The Synod will begin with an Ecumenical Vigil on the 30th of September 2023. This will be followed by a retreat, to underline that this indeed is about discerning the will of God and not a parliamentary session, from the 1st to the 3rd of October.

I ask that you accompany the Holy Father, Pope Francis, the participants and this whole process and journey with your prayers invoking the Holy Spirit to bless, guide and direct our hearts. Every one of us is therefore urged to allow the Holy Spirit to transform us. After the Synod we will be asked to find ways to reap the fruits of this historical assembly of the representatives of the whole Church. I ask you to continue reflecting on synodality and its practical implications for our Church in Southern Africa and for our beautiful Diocese of Kokstad.

As we do so, let us keep in mind that everyone counts, everyone has a voice, and everyone is at home in the Diocese regardless of age, race, gender, language, social standing, or any other distinction. In fact, the Synod asks all of us to "Enlarge the place of your tent, stretch your tent curtains wide, do not hold back; lengthen your cords, strengthen your stakes..." (Isaiah 54:2).

One celebration to look forward to, is the centenary celebration for our majestic Cathedral on the Feast of St Patrick, our Patron Saint, on the 17th of March 2024. Let us make this celebration a memorable one; a time to celebrate our faith and heritage; a time to paint Kokstad Green!!!

Maria Telgte was founded by the Servant of God, Abbot Francis Pfanner, and his Trappist Monks of Mariannhill, in 1895. You are cordially invited to join me on this pilgrimage to honour the Cross of our Lord Jesus Christ, the symbol of our salvation. It is that Holy Cross under which Our Lady, the Virgin Mary, the Mother of Sorrows stood.

We, her daughters, and sons, pray that through her intercession we too may be granted the grace to be faithful disciples of her son, Our Lord Jesus Christ, and embrace His Cross to be crowned together with her and all the Saints in His Kingdom.





DIOCESAN UPDATES.

On 1 May 2023 the grounds of St Patrick's Cathedral were abuzz with the vibrant bustle of young people from all the corners of the diocese of Kokstad. These young people had responded to the call of the most reverend shepherd of the diocese. The 'open day' as dubbed by the Bishop, provided a platform for robust and spirited conversations pertaining the youth ministry of the diocese. The conversations ranged from the socioeconomic issues affecting the youth, to the challenges in the church that impede youth participation in the life of the church.

In his closing statement, the Bishop reiterated the words of the Holy Father Pope Francis, that young people are not simply the future of the church: rather they are its the present. After the talks and discussions, the young people of the diocese departed with the blessing and reassurance of support from the Bishop, motivated to reimagine the youth ministry and employ their youthful spirit in its restoration.





On 8 July 2023 parish youth representatives were once again invited to the cathedral for a follow up meeting. The Bishop graced this with his presence and gathering exhortation of encouragement to the young people. All parishes were represented and from this gathering an interim youth executive was chosen; tasked with team responsibility of starting the ground work of the restoration of the youth ministry. Each deanery nominated 3 young people to the team, the intention being the need to understand the climate of each deanery and produce a cohesive plan of action that will accommodate all differences.

The interim youth structure is continuously engaged in spirited discussions about activities and policies that will revive youth participation in church and simultaneously provide spaces for young people to enrich their spiritual lives. With the grace of God, we shall soon see the fruits of their labour.



Kokstad Diocesan Pastoral Council Annual General Meeting (AGM) 21/07/2023

The Diocese of Kokstad held its AGM on the 21st of July 2023 at St. Patrick's Cathedral in Kokstad.

This was the first AGM of His Lordship, Bishop Thulani Victor Mbuyisa CMM as President of KODPAC. The meeting invited the Clergy, KODPAC Executive, Parish Pastoral Councils, Religious Sisters, Sodalities, Diocesan Teams, and Youth representatives. The gathering was well published on the diocesan social platforms to inform and remind the faithful about it.



The meeting was well attended as registered delegates constituted 98% attendance. Bishop Thulani addressed the AGM, highlighting key aspects of the diocese, successes, difficulties and young people, and their needs. He reflected on the recent Ad Limina visit held beginning of July 2023 in Rome, which he said happens after every four years, when the Bishops also have an opportunity to visit the tombs of the apostles Saints Peter and Paul.



The meeting accepted reports from KODPAC Executive, Parishes, Sodalities, Religious Sisters, and Diocesan Teams. The reports highlighted the scope of work, ongoing formation, involvement of young people, challenges, and recommendations. The reports were discussed and open-minded resolutions were taken.

The AGM also witnessed and received the Kokstad Diocese Pastoral Council Statutes and Deanery Pastoral Council Statutes that were promulgated into Law by His Lordship, Bishop Thulani Victor Mbuyisa CMM during the closing Mass of the AGM.



The statutes were reviewed during the Clergy Study week held in May 2023 through the work of the Director for Canonical Affairs, Rev Fr Aviwe Augustus Biata.




The St. Anne's
