# **Pre-elections for the Regional Superior**

On the 28<sup>th</sup> of November 2022, after consulting the GG, I explained to those who attended the retreat the procedure of the pre-election process for the Regional Superior. Ballot papers were given to the chairpersons of the Zones to ensure that, each Confrere receives a ballot paper from the chairperson and submit to the chairperson after nominating and filling in three names of his preferred candidates for the Regional Superior. The young Confreres from Merrivale also received the ballot papers except for those who had already left for their home-leave (2 had left already). The submitted ballot papers were counted at the Regional Council meeting on the 13<sup>th</sup> December 2022, and the results were published. Again, ballot papers were sent out through the chairpersons of the Zones and the deadline for submission was clearly given as the 16<sup>th</sup> of January 2023. On the same day (16<sup>th</sup> January 2023), the Regional Council met and received in total 23 sealed envelopes which were packaged and entrusted to 2 Councillors to send by courier direct to the Superior General in Mariannhill. A few students who had not returned from home-leave will submit their ballots in person to the

Superior General at Mariannhill on the 25<sup>th</sup> January on their way to the retreat. Please note that, this process is only a consultative vote. The final decision will be made by the Superior General and his Council, based not only on the outcome of the second ballot but on their discretion. Therefore, you can expect the announcement of the new Regional Superior before the end of January 2023.

# **Election of Regional Councillors**

At the Regional Chapter to be held on the 1<sup>st</sup> February 2023, we will have the opportunity to elect four (4) Regional Councillors who will, together with the new Regional Superior, constitute the Leadership Team of our Region of Mthatha.

# Agenda of the Regional Chapter

At the Regional Council meeting held on the 16<sup>th</sup> January 2023, the leadership team agreed to a proposal to limit the items of the agenda of the day to two key issues namely; election of Councillors and presentations of the three delegates on the General Chapter 2022. The election of Councillors will be a process of reflection and discernment, and will be done in stages. In this regard, 2 Councillors will be elected in the morning (before lunch) and the other 2 in the afternoon. The three delegates will present on different ACTS OF THE GENERAL CHAPTER 2022 and there will be time for clarifications, comments and discussions. These two key issues are of a serious nature to last us the whole day. To this end, there will be another Regional Assembly later during the year (around June or July) where other outstanding issues, including reports etc will be presented and discussed.

### **Priestly ordinations**

It is my pleasure to announce to you that:

Rev. Deacon Jackson Mandela Likabo CMM will be ordained a Priest on the 11<sup>th</sup> March 2023 at his home Parish of Eregi by his Lordship, Bishop Joseph Obanyi Sagwe of the Diocese of Kakamega. Fr Thomas Wao CMM will represent our Region of Mthatha at the ordination. Deacon Mandela is currently on home-leave which he is spending doing some pastoral work at his Parish. We are grateful to the Region of East Africa for all the support they are giving to Deacon Mandela as he prepares for his ordination. On his return, Deacon Mandela will work as an assistant Priest to Fr Mandla Mchunu CMM while residing at Abbot

Francis Home. Our plan is that, he will slowly be initiated into formation ministry and later take charge of the candidacy and postulant programmes.

Rev, Deacon Joel Bokoyo Mpembe CMM will be ordained a Priest on the 18<sup>th</sup> March 2023 at Mariazell Mission by His Lordship, Bishop Sithembele Sipuka of the Catholic Diocese of Mthatha. Let us keep our Confreres in prayer and give them the necessary support as they prepare for their special day of ordination.
