EAST AFRICA CIRCULAR LETTER: OCTOBER 2021

Dear Confreres,

Greetings of love and peace from Christ the Prophet Community (CPC) and the Region of East Africa. We continue to battle through COVID-19 as the whole world looks forward to some kind of "normal life" back again. It is gratifying to note that a number of you Confreres have already received full vaccination or have received the first dose and now waiting for your next appointment for the second dose. We thank God that no one in our Region has died from this "invisible enemy" so far, although a number of us have seen people close to us, in our parishes and families, succumb to this terrible disease. A number of us in the Region, especially at CPC, have in the past tested positive to COVID-19 and recovered: we praise God. Having said that, let us continue to keep guard against this disease by observing Government regulations for prevention of the spread of COVID-19. It is consoling to see the Faithful back in our churches in both Kenya and Tanzania .
